Scholar-In-Residence Program of the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative

The Scholar-In-Residence (hereafter “The Scholar”) of the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative is a full-time matriculated graduate student attending a graduate school institution locally whose field of study includes a local focus. See [CBC Scholar-in-Residence webpage](#) for examples. The scholarship produced when shared with the community at large, would enrich the knowledge and understanding of the diverse history and culture of the Main Line and environs. While The Scholar is enrolled in a graduate studies program, the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative will provide a \$250 per year stipend, up to a \$500 maximum award, to be used as desired, with no reporting required (e.g. for books, research, etc.). It is intended there is only one Scholar-in-Residence at a time.

At the completion of studies, The Scholar will offer a public presentation (in person or virtual) sponsored by the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative, preferably in April of the year of graduation. It is intended that this presentation be an opportunity for The Scholar to have a “capstone” experience, sharing their learning with the Main Line community (and beyond).

Applications to be the Scholar-In-Residence of the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative will be received beginning April 1 and postmarked by April 30. Applications will be reviewed in May. If the review committee determines there is no applicant who meets the eligibility criteria to be Scholar-In-Residence in a given year, the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative reserves the right not to select a candidate that year.

The applicant for the Scholar-In-Residence program of the CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative must provide the following materials sent in one envelope and postmarked by April 30, to CBC, PO BOX 135, Villanova, PA 19085:

- 1) a completed CommUNITY Breakfast Collaborative Scholar-In-Residence application
- 2) a cover letter describing interest and fit for this position, as well as the reason for wanting to be a Scholar-in-Residence; the intended area of research, as much as it is known, and the start and completion dates of study
- 3) a copy of the letter of acceptance to the graduate school institution to be attended
- 4) a copy of the registration for the courses intended to be taken the first semester
- 5) one letter of recommendation from a faculty member from your undergraduate institution
- 6) a *Curriculum Vitae* (CV)
- 7) a JPG headshot color photo

If an application has merit, the applicant will then be contacted for an interview. If chosen, the selected applicant will be notified, and a meeting will be scheduled to award the first portion of the stipend, usually in June. At that time a press release will be issued announcing the appointment of the Scholar-in-Residence to this honorary position, accompanied by the provided headshot photo.
